



CALL FOR SUMMER RESIDENCY WITH FALL EXHIBITION

The Borland Project Space (BPS) is pleased to announce a call for its 2019 summer residency. We welcome proposals from graduate students, recent graduates, and advanced undergraduates from the College of Arts and Architecture. Projects should activate 125 Borland while addressing the BPS mandate of “arts research revealed.” The space will remain open to the public Monday-Friday, 8:30–5:00 PM, and the resident will be expected to activate the space [i.e., be present working or otherwise have work on view and be willing to share that work with the general public] for a minimum of ten hours per week. The residency will end with a two-week project exhibition at the beginning of the fall 2010 semester. Please note that the project space is inside a historic building that houses staff offices. Work that uses loud tools or chemicals is not permitted.

The residency comes with a materials and research budget of \$500.

DETAILS

- Residents may occupy the space beginning May 14, 2019 through August 17, 2019.
- Between August 20, 2018 and August 31, 2018 an exhibition of the resident’s summer research work will be displayed in the project space.
- To apply, submit a short description (maximum 250 words) detailing how the space will be used, how the resident’s project meets the goal of “revealing arts research,” and how their research will be displayed during the two-week exhibition period.
